Getting involved

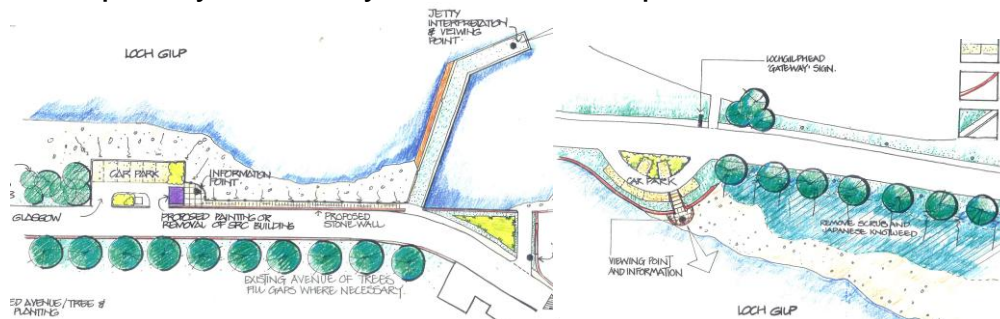
We want to know your thoughts about Lochgilphead. What do you like about the place? What don't you like? And what would you like improved? Now is your chance to tell us what you think.

The proposals could include new landscaping, information boards and parking. Is there one road approach which should have priority? Are any other works required?

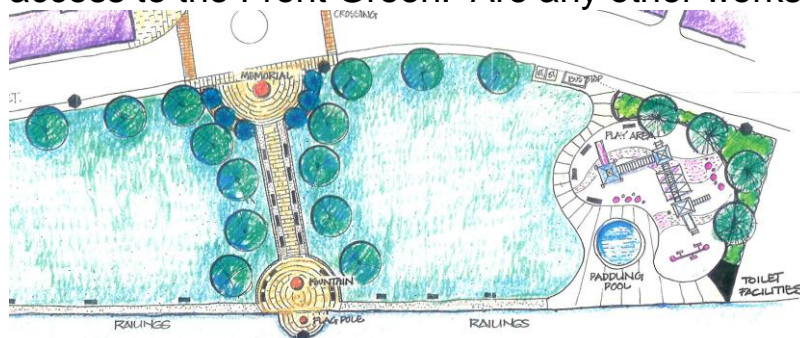


The Clock Lodge
